

Updated 2023-2024 COVID-19 Vaccines

The updated 2023–2024 COVID-19 vaccines offer better protection and are the best way to maintain protection against severe illness from current COVID-19 variants. Get an updated COVID-19 vaccine to protect yourself this fall and winter.

An updated vaccine is recommended for everyone ages 6 months and older.



- Everyone **5 years of age and older** is eligible to receive an updated COVID-19 vaccine, at least 2 months since their last dose.
- Recommendations for infants and toddlers **6 months - 4 years** depends on the number of COVID-19 vaccines previously received. Please check with your child's primary healthcare provider.

Free Vaccines

The vaccine is free for most people who have private insurance, Medi-Cal and Medicare

Children without health insurance can get free vaccines through the Vaccines for Children Program. For more information, visit: cdc.gov/vaccines/programs/vfc/parents

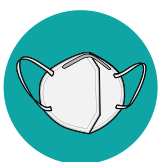
