

COVID-19 MAA Activity Examples

| Activity Code | Activity Description | Examples |
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| 2 | Direct Patient Care | Administering a COVID-19 test kit to an individual. |
| 2 | Direct Patient Care | Conducting a laboratory test for COVID-19. |
| 2 | Direct Patient Care | The delivering of medical resources/medical supplies (including COVID-19 test kits) to a physical location. |
| 2 | Direct Patient Care | Time spent tracking medical supplies (including COVID-19 test kits). |
| 4 | Medi-Cal Outreach | Explaining to an individual/family that treatment for COVID-19 is a Medi-Cal covered benefit and encouraging them to apply. |
| 4 | Medi-Cal Outreach | Informing/linking them to locations where the COVID-19 test is given (e.g. doctor's office, clinics, drive thru locations, etc.) |
| 4 or 6 | Medi-Cal Outreach | Outreach campaign in the community to encourage individuals to get a COVID-19 vaccination. |
| 4 or 6 | Medi-Cal Outreach | Informing an individual/family where they can go to receive a COVID-19 vaccination. |
| 4 or 6 | Medi-Cal Outreach | Creating and handing out flyers that contain information about the COVID-19 vaccination locations. |
| 4 or 6 | Medi-Cal Outreach/ Referral, Coordination & Monitoring of Medi-Cal Services | Helping/linking individuals locate resources to assist with COVID-19 testing and/or treatment. |
| 4 or 6 | Medi-Cal Outreach/ Referral, Coordination & Monitoring of Medi-Cal Services | Community members calling in to county departments where the calls result in referrals to primary care providers, hospitals or other healthcare facilities. |
| 6 | Referral, Coordination & Monitoring of Medi-Cal Services | Monitoring an individual who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 and is in isolation in order to make timely referrals to additional healthcare services - if needed. |
| 17 | Program Planning & Policy Development | COVID-19 vaccination clinic planning, especially for satellite, temporary or off-site clinics. |
| 17 | Program Planning & Policy Development | Planning for and assembling a network of COVID-19 vaccination providers in accessible settings. |
| 17 | Program Planning & Policy Development | Efforts made to recruit and enroll enough providers to vaccinate critical populations and eventually the general population. |
| 17 | Program Planning & Policy Development | Strategizing and working with local stakeholders on how best to conduct COVID-19 vaccine education and outreach. |
| 17 | Program Planning & Policy Development | Coordinating with state and local agencies to partner with other stakeholders to promote coordinated messaging around COVID-19 vaccines. |
| 17 | Program Planning & Policy Development | Reviewing immunization messaging to ensure that it is accurate and up to date. Review the accuracy of translated materials and determine if the language reflects Medi-Cal populations. |
| 17 | Program Planning & Policy Development | Collecting COVID-19 infection data, analyzing data, preparing report(s). |
| 17 | Program Planning & Policy Development | Planning activities directed at informing county residents where they can go to receive COVID-19 tests and treatment. |
| 17 | Program Planning & Policy Development | Planning for the healthcare needs of disadvantaged/ vulnerable populations (e.g. homeless). |
| 17 | Program Planning & Policy Development | Gathering data for websites and/or reports on COVID-19 - # of positive tests, hospitalizations, ICU beds, demographic information - where the underlying purpose is to build capacity in order to be able to provide effective healthcare services. |
| 18 | SPMP Program Planning & Policy Development | Researching COVID-19 Situation Reports from the World Health Organization (WHO) with an eye towards creating treatment protocols to better fight the disease. MUST HAVE a SPMP License to use this code! |
| 18 | SPMP Program Planning & Policy Development | Planning related to developing written recommendations for medical providers for managing/providing treatment for persons infected with or suspected to be infected with COVID-19. MUST HAVE a SPMP License to use this code! |
| 18 | SPMP Program Planning & Policy Development | Planning and consulting with health care providers, emergency medical response services, hospitals, long term care facilities and other healthcare facilities around clinical aspects of testing and caring for persons testing positive for COVID-19. Developing medically-related guidelines and procedures for these programs. MUST HAVE a SPMP License to use this code! |
